

**CALL FOR APPLICATIONS FOR A REIMBURSEMENT FOR REGISTRATION FEES AND ATTENDANCE AT THE ARPM –
ADVANCED RISK AND PORTFOLIO MANAGEMENT COURSE**

This call is reserved for E&DS (or former - EIF) MSc students.

Quant Boot camp will take place remotely August 1-6, 2022

REGULATION

Article 1

(Call for application subject)

- a) The Department of Economics of the University of Genoa launches a call for applications for the Academic Year 2021-2022 to give 3 \$ 750 grants for the three best applicants shortlisted
- b) The selected students will be given the grants as a repayment for the tuition and enrollment fees to participate to the ARPM – Advanced Risk and Portfolio Management Course. To get the repayment the students have to take the ARPM course payment receipt and the certificate of attendance at the ARPM course to the Department Offices.
- c) The attendees are entitled to receive 3 ECTS

Article 2

(Requirements)

The selection is reserved for E&DS (or former EIF) MSc students who:

- a) are regularly enrolled in the 2021-2022 Academic Year
- b) have passed Econometrics and Software – R exams or other equivalent exams
- c) get a score in the SECS-S/01; SECS-S/06; SECS-P/05 disciplines not less than 25/30

Article 3

(How to apply)

The students must fill in the form attached to the call for applications and provide the following documents:

- a) a copy of a valid identity document
 - b) a copy of the ARPM – Boot camp payment receipt
 - c) a copy of the academic transcript of records
 - d) a formal certification or a self-certification which certifies other educational qualifications (e. g. Master).
- These documents will be checked by the University Administration.

The filled in form and the above listed documents must be sent to didattica@economia.unige.it by 6 pm of **May 20, 2022**. The subject line topic has to be "Request for tuition and enrollment fees repayment to participate to ARPM course".

Article 4

(Selection Committee and selection criteria)

- a) The Selection Committee's members appointed by the E&DS course are: Professor Pier Giuseppe Giribone and Professor Maria Laura Torrente.

Firstly, the Selection Committee will examine the students' requirements and the application correctness

- b) Secondly, the Selection Committee will assess each applicant then select the three best ones by considering :
 - the applicant's average mark (this requirement will be given 20 points at most)
 - the score got by the students in the SECS-S/01; SECS-S/06; SECS-P/05 disciplines (this requirement will be given 20 points at most)

- the applicant's English skills (motivational interview) – (this requirement will be given 20 points at most)

c) In *ex-aequo* cases the Selection Committee will consider the student's family income, which will be verified by examining:

-Italian students: the ISEE certification

-foreign students: other equivalent certifications.

In case of equity the Selection Committee will draw among them.

d) After listing the applicants' assessments the Selection Committee will decide whether to award the grant or not.

Article 5

(Assessment report and acceptance of the grant)

The result of the selection will be communicated to the applicants by e-mail to the e-mail address indicated in the application by **June 1st, 2022**.

The winners must declare to accept the grant sending an e-mail to didattica@economia.unige.it and writing in the subject line "Acceptance of the repayment for the enrollment and attendance fees to participate to the 6-day Course Advanced Risk and Portfolio Management – Boot camp".

In case of non- acceptance, the winners must immediately send an e-mail to didattica@economia.unige.it, to consent the Selection Committee to assign the grant to other applicants on the basis of their positions in the ranking.

Article 6

(Grant assignment)

The Department will repay the tuition and enrollment fees to the selection winners after the course has taken place. The applicants must produce the payment receipt and the attendance certificate. Each applicant can get the grant only once.
