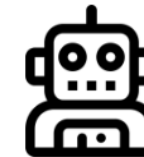
## A multidisciplinary PhD program on Security, Risk and Vulnerability

This specific curriculum in Management and Security is designed to equip its [PhD students](#) with the **theoretical and analytical instruments** necessary to understand various business, **management and security dimensions**, to use theoretical models and conduct empirical, high-quality analysis at the frontier of managerial research. Such instruments are acquired through the attendance to **advanced methodological, disciplinary and specialty courses** that explore the different ways in which security, risk, and vulnerability issues play out in the business and managerial world both in research and in practice.

In particular, courses are classified in 4 types:

- CROSS-curricula courses, i.e. courses that cover topics that are relevant to two or more curricula;
- CORE-curriculum courses, i.e. courses covering topics that are specific to a given curriculum and provide foundational knowledge and skills which are essential for developing the specific research topic selected by the student;
- FUNDAMENTALS, i.e. courses aiming to provide the basics of topics inherent to a given curriculum to students of other curricula. In general, these courses cannot be taken by students enrolled in the curriculum already specifically addressed to the topic investigated;
- courses on SOFT SKILLS e.g., how to write a paper, how to write a research grant, and how to perform the management of research.

# Ph.D in Strategic Engineering and Decision Methods



- **Coordinator:** Prof. Anna Sciomachen
- **Overview:**
- The **international** PhD course in SEDEM is promoted by DIEC in collaboration with some international universities focused on the new discipline called Strategic Engineering:
  - IMT Ecole Des Mines de Ales (*Information Structures Systems*),
  - Óbuda University , Hungary (Applied Informatics and Applied Mathematics),
  - Hellenic Mediterranean University, Greece (*Energy and Computer Engineering*).
- The idea is to create experts able to design, develop, use and finalize new solutions that guarantee a strategic advantage in the decision-making process.
- PhD students will focus on developing a combined use of Modeling, Simulation, Algorithms, Data Analytics and Artificial Intelligence closely related to Big Data, to support Decision Makers in a wide range of applications, such as logistics and transportation, telecommunications, defense, finance, medical sciences and biotechnology.
- The strongly transdisciplinary nature of the course is highlighted.
